

Commissioners and Montreat residents,

The NC State Board of Elections provides links to crucial information for Montreat voters:

(1) Location of voting location on Nov. 3rd when registered voters MUST vote in their precinct :

If using these links, Montreat residents zipcode 28757 cannot access them unless they enter Black Mountain zipcode 28711,

Restating, Montreat zipcode 28757 will Not Work, the "system" requires entering Black Mountain zipcode 28711, then these links from the NC State Board of Elections will work.

The Buncombe County Board of Elections has been advised. Nothing will change before the current election.

Buncombe County Board of Elections Chairman Jake Quinn plans to again broach the matter with the State Board of Elections and work towards resolving this long standing address issue.

October 9 is the last day to register to vote on Election Day, Nov 3rd.

In person early voting is available at multiple locations around the county listed on the Buncombe County Board of Elections. Early voting begins October 15 at 8 am and ends at 3 pm on Saturday October 31.

Residents can register if they need to do so and vote at the same time at any of the early voting sites listed on the Buncombe County website.

The Black Mountain Library is one of the early voting sites.
